## Tie-Breaking Procedures

At the end of the round robin portion, if there are any two-way ties in overall match records, the result will determine which teams places higher.

For a 3-or-more-way tie, head-to-head results will still be the first tie breaker. That is, if one of the tied teams beat all the others in head-to-head, that team gets top place.

In the event of a "perfect triangle" or "perfect square," etc., where the tied teams have all beaten one another, then the set record percentages are used to break the tie.

Example: Team $A$ beats team $B$ in 2 sets, $B$ defeats $C$ in 3 , and $C$ beats $A$ in 3 . Within this triangle, Team A is first at 3-2 (60\%), C second at 3-3 (50\%), and B third at 2-3 (40\%)

If a tie still exists (i.e. all teams beat each other in 3 sets), then the team with the least points allowed only within the matches among the tied teams gets the top place.

In the very unlikely event a tie still exists, then the teams will be ranked by the least points allowed in all of the tournament matches played, not just those among the teams with tied records.

The last option is to flip a coin or roll a die to determine placing among tied teams.
